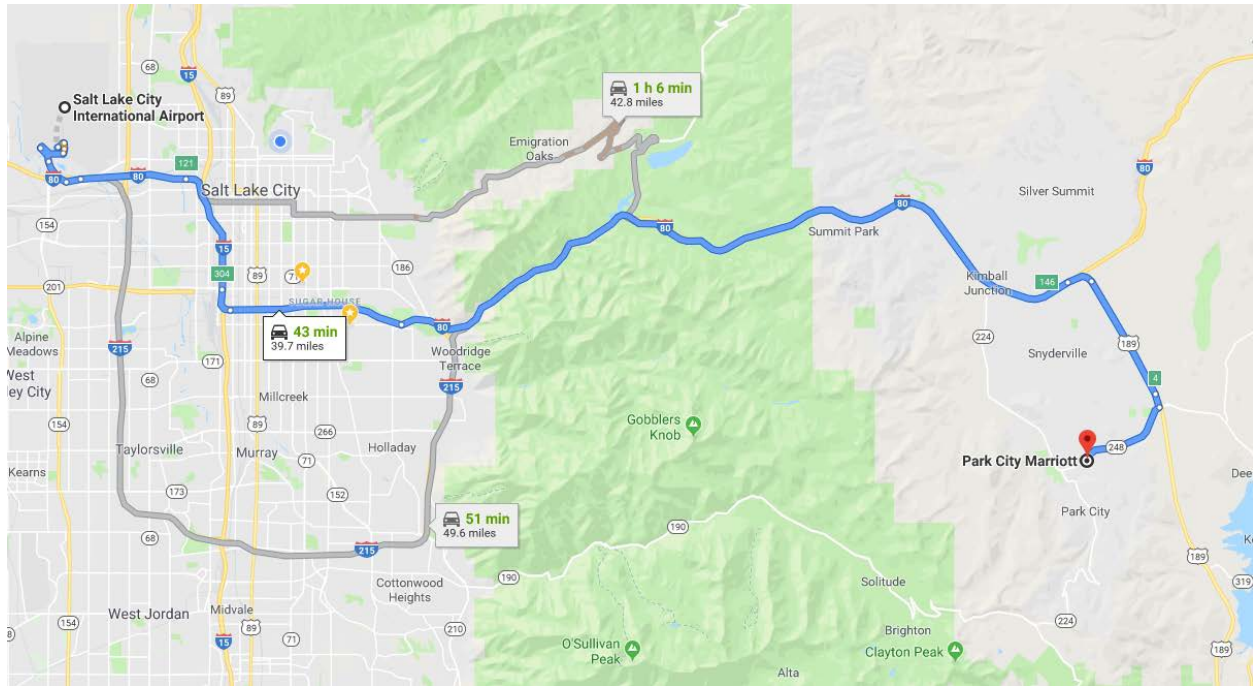


Travel and weather details:

Salt Lake International Airport is about 40 miles from Park City, Utah.



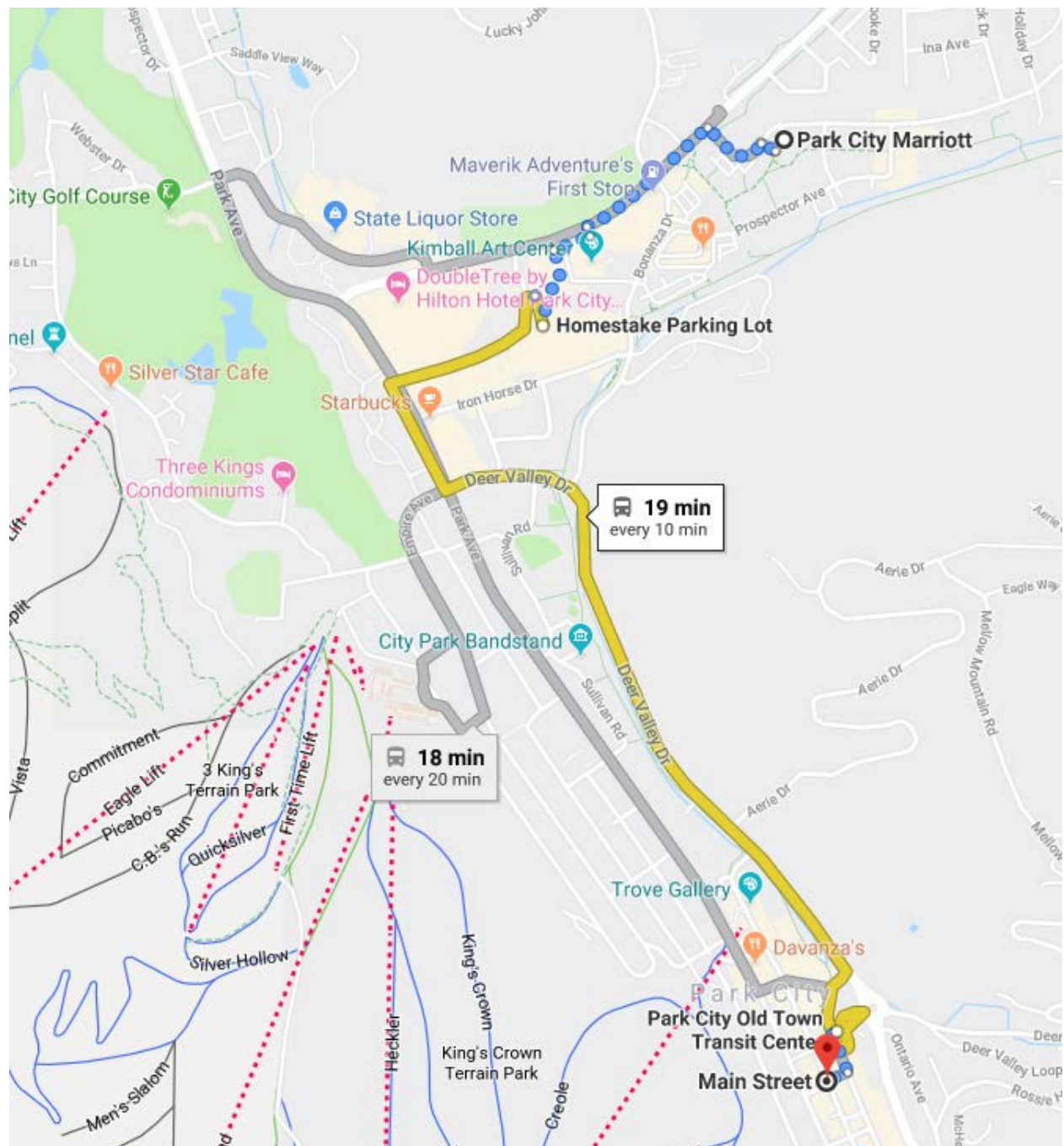
Both [Uber](#) and [Lyft](#) operate in Salt Lake City, fares are comparable to Park City, around \$40-50 from the airport to the hotel.

There is a [Hertz car rental](#) onsite at the Park City Marriott.

[Canyon Transportation](#) is the service recommended by several Park City Hotels for airport shuttle service. The cost they list on their website is \$41 for a shared ride one way from the airport.

Getting around Park City will be easy. The Park City Marriott is not on Main Street, but there's a free city shuttle that runs up and down Main Street. If you're so inclined, there are bike rental shops nearby, including one in the hotel.



Weather in August will likely be warm, typically higher 80s, during the day but cooling off quite a bit at night. Layering is key to managing the changing temperatures, bring a fleece or jacket for evening outings. (For point of reference, when we perform at Deer Valley in the summer, the first half of the concert is usually warm, the second half we add sweaters and turn the heaters on.)

Utah is quite arid, and Park City is at 7000 feet above sea level. Be prepared with sunscreen, eyedrops, lotions, and drink lots of water while you're here.
