*While Abravanel Hall, our home concert hall is in Salt Lake City, our summer home is in Park City at the Deer Valley Music Festival, so hosting this year's ICSOM conference in the mountains seemed like a perfect fit. Park City is about 40 miles southeast of Salt Lake City in the Wasatch Mountains. An old mining town turned mountain resort town, Park City has a beautiful historic Main Street with many shops, art galleries, restaurants, and even a couple of Banksy murals. You can ride a scenic chair lift or gondola ride to the top of Park City Mountain and hike or bike down the mountain, or just ride back down for a different view. Getting around Park City will be easy using the free Park City Transit System.*

*Salt Lake City has grown tremendously in the years since we last hosted an ICSOM Conference in 2005. We have countless new restaurants, bars, and downtown is teeming with activity. If you have extra time to spend in Salt Lake City, you'll find no shortage of art galleries, museums, theaters, and other cultural activities to enjoy.*

*We hope that while you are planning your conference trip, you'll consider adding a few extra days to see some of the scenery that Utah has to offer. Not only do we have the mountains surrounding Salt Lake City, we also have the red rock country in southern Utah. Visit any of our "Mighty 5" National Parks, including Arches, Bryce Canyon, Canyonlands, Capitol Reef, and Zion National Parks.*

*Utah just celebrated 150 years since the driving of the Golden Spike, and the Golden Spike National Historic Park is about an hour and a half drive north of Salt Lake City. Nearby is the Bear River Migratory Bird Refuge, and if you've got a decent car you can take the road out to Rozel Point on the Great Salt Lake to see Robert Smithson's earthwork called the Spiral Jetty.*

*The mixer will be held onsite at the Park City Marriott on a lovely patio with a firepit. Park City can be quite cool at night, so bring a sweater! We look forward to seeing you in Utah in August!*
